Introduction to Algebraic Structures

Algebraic structures are sets equipped with one or more operations.

- Examples: Groups, Rings, Fields.

Algebraic Structures must satisfy Properties

| Structure | Must Satisfy Properties |
|-----------|------------------------------------------------------|
| Group | Closure, Associative, Identity, Inverse |
| Ring | Closure, Associative, Identity, Inverse, Commutative |
| Field | Closure, Associative, Identity, Inverse, Commutative |

Algebraic systems

- $N = \{1, 2, 3, 4, \dots, \infty\}$ = Set of all natural numbers.
- $Z = \{0, \pm 1, \pm 2, \pm 3, \pm 4, \dots, \infty\}$ = Set of all integers.
- Q = Set of all rational numbers.
- R = Set of all real numbers.

- Binary Operation:** The binary operator $*$ is said to be a binary operation (closed operation) on a non empty set A , if $a * b \in A$ for all $a, b \in A$ (Closure property).
Ex: The set N is closed with respect to addition and multiplication but not w.r.t subtraction and division.
- Algebraic System:** A set ' A ' with one or more binary (closed) operations defined on it is called an algebraic system.
Ex: $(N, +)$, $(Z, +, -)$, $(R, +, \cdot)$ are algebraic systems.
