In this academic year 2021-2022 our college has been recognized by the UGC under section 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956 and is affiliated to the University of Madras. Our College offering various undergraduate and postgraduate programs in arts and science disciplines. This academic year we were adept to replete a total of 839 Seats and technological advancements are seamlessly integrated into the infrastructure, enhancing the learning experience. Overall 19 values added courses were conducted to enhance the students' skill by which 1506 students got benefited. In total, our college has a committed faculty team of 105 members who consistently provide support ensuring students have access to resources and essential guidance.

Our Faculties from all departments have published various research articles in various journals and books and also participate in various conferences, seminars, workshops and FDP. For the development of students we have collaborated with 6 companies and motivated the students to participate in Internships and Training Programs. Our College Physical Director provides continuous sports and games uplifting training for all the students. Medals and Certificates were distributed to the winners and runners for the various sports events conducted in the college. In order to nurture patriotism in students' minds, our college celebrates Independence Day and Republic Day every year. To promote and cultivate the culture and tradition, our college organizes various celebrations like Pongal, Ayudha Pooja and Christmas. Our college encourages co-curricular and extra-curricular activities for holistic development of our students. 1487 students were benefited by the guidance for competitive exams and career counseling offered by the institution. To facilitate the college education of the students the college management arranges a monetary help by providing them scholarships. Our management has been encouraging the meritorious sports excellent and economically downtrodden students by means of awarding scholarships at the time of admission in terms of fee waving. 1258 students were benefited with management scholarship of ₹20,79,200/-. Moreover, 593 students benefited from various government bodies receiving scholarship of ₹45, 72,618/-.

Through its meticulous planning and execution, the IQAC has effectively promoted research culture and faculty development within our institution.
